



Configurations and Limitations

Adobe Acrobat Configuration suggestions

- 1.Edit/Preferences/Display: "Smooth Line Art" must be selected.
- 2.Edit/Preferences/Display: "Default Zoom" is recommended to be set to "Fit in Window".

Limitations

- 1.Acrobat Reader does not currently support "Search" in Linux. As result the "Search" page on this CD will not work in Linux. A solution is to use "Find" inside the "All Authors" or "All Papers" pages.
- 2.The search options provided in the "Search" page are not working in Acrobat 4
- 3.The Search does not work in Acrobat 5.00. It works correctly in Acrobat 6. All users of Acrobat 5.00 are advised to upgrade to Acrobat 6. The upgrade can be downloaded for free from www.adobe.com.
- 4.In Acrobat 4 and previous versions some of the pages look bad due to the lack of "Transparency".

Known defects

1. Search does not work in Acrobat Reader 5.00. The JavaScripts attached to the Search page are not recognized. Search page is missing all its functionalities.
Solution: Use the Acrobat from the CD or upgrade your Acrobat to 5.05 or newer.
- 2.The contents of few papers have not been indexed correctly. This happens because the Acrobat Search/Indexing engine was not able to correctly open and index the content of these papers, even though Acrobat is able to open and display correctly these papers.
Solution: Search will work correctly for these cases only when searching in: Abstract content, Title, Authors, Organization, Country, Paper ID.
